The Amateur Comedy Club is a private not for profit theater club located in an historic building in the Murray Hill section of Manhattan. The Club has been performing plays continuously since 1884. In addition to our shows the Club has a regular schedule of special events, performances and parties throughout our season. Within each season, we produce a Fall, Winter and Spring "major" show, as well as such special projects as our Shakespeare Brunch, our Robert Burns Night, and a One Act Play Festival. Our Clubhouse is filled with historic photograms, drawings and other material dating from the nineteenth century. Our theater can hold up to 110 guests, and can be configured in a variety of ways, including theater in the round. Our most recent performances have included Murder on the Nile, by Agatha Christie, How the Other Half Loves, by Alan Ayckbourn and Sunshine Boys by Neil Simon. Our performances have covered a wide full range of drama, comedy, musical, historic and contemporary plays.

We are a membership organization, with about 100 "Active" members, and 250 "Associate" members. Actives have full access and keys to our clubhouse, and can act in our shows. Associate members are invited, with their guests to our performances, special events and parties. While we hold casting calls for our auditions, and hire professional directors, much of everything else is done by our Active members - set design and construction, light and sound design and operations, stage management and production. As a private club, we perform our show for our own pleasure and the pleasure of our guests. Admission is by invitation only, and there is no charge for our performances.
